### Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for your continued support in ensuring your child is prepared for their time in school. As we move into the Christmas period we have a range of activities and events being planned for the pupils in school, so I am taking this opportunity to remind you to please check the home/school diary on a daily basis. Children and Staff joined in the spirit of Children in Need Day with a total of £90 being raised for the charity. Thanks to Falcon Class pupils for their work in arranging the day and to you as parents for your generous donations.

As part of the ongoing work we do with the pupils around keeping safe we welcomed the crew from Wheatley Fire Station to the school. The pupils enjoyed their time learning about fire safety, seeing the fire tender and really engaged in the opportunity to ask questions and think about how they should respond to situations and to keep themselves and others safe. For Anti-Bullying week last week the children had a special assembly led by Mrs Lee which was followed up in classes with discussions and an activity about positive changes we can make in school. Mrs Lee will be leading a follow-up assembly next week where the children will hear the outcomes from this.

Part of the development of the curriculum at school has involved teachers increasing opportunities for the pupils to engage in outdoor and off-site learning. The children have been enjoying their outdoor learning and off-site trips. Key Stage 2 pupils enjoyed a successful trip to The Steam Museum at Swindon and engaged in a number of workshops during their visit. Wren and Robin Class have enjoyed successful visits to Cutteslowe Park and, as part of their Road Safety Week activities, Wren class have been out in the local area practising their road safety skills.

Pupils in Red Kite and Falcon class have been fortunate to have a lovely afternoon participating in craft activities with pupils from St Edward's School and are looking forward to the second afternoon in couple of weeks time. We are grateful to St Edward's school for their ongoing support of the work we do here at Northern House, Oxford.
